#### The Union of Free Evangelical and Baptist Churches of Estonia Estonian Free Church Theological Seminary Curriculum: Theology and Society 120 EAP (ECTS credit points)

Four major modules offer together 90 EAP (including 10 EAP for practicum) Module of elective courses 10 EAP Module of Master's thesis 20 EAP.

**Objectives of the curriculum:** the objective of the educators is to train specialists, who have competence in development of the church and missionary presence in the society. The successful completion of the curriculum enables graduates to work both in public sector and church environment and to pursue studies at a doctorate level.

### Learning outcomes of the curriculum

The curriculum offers students competences in:

- reflecting on personal and church spirituality in dialogue with the development of the Christian church, religious, Biblical and cultural history;
- applying the practices of hermeneutics to the Bible study in the Free Church context, enabling incarnation of its missionary message in the local community;
- analysing different phenomena in social and church context in the light of the Biblical teaching and offer justified and innovative solutions to the occuring problems;
- involving different parties and invest in people according to discipleship principles, in order to increase the trust in churches and the whole society;
- analysing and synthesizing the research data in a creative way and to applying it in responding to the theologically established question of the Master's thesis.

The module offers students competences in:

- knowledge of the Bible and analysing skills of the meaning of its parts and entire content from the perspective of church and social life;

- wording and contextualizing major questions of ethics and mission on local and global level, based on the Bible message;

• analysing the differences and similarities of the religious experience and religious identity, using references to the research data of sociology of religion.

# Module of Master's thesis 20 EAP (TÜ.06)

## Learning outcomes

The completion of the module of Master's thesis offers students competences in:

- analyising the points of contact of theology and context, and respective problems;
- planning, managing and analyising the process of completing the Master's thesis;
- linking the Biblical and church teaching with modern social themes, offering justified and creative solutions to address some emerging issues;
- analyising and synthesizing creatively the collected data and applying it to the area of Master's thesis in order to answer the theologically raised question;
- defending the Master's paper in public in clear and intelligible manner, justifying the work using all knowledge acquired during completion of the whole curriculum.
